

### MAIN BAR – FIRST UP



#### 1. HARROGATE BREWING CO. (HARROGATE) – BEECHING AXE 5.2% IPA

Balanced IPA style beer with Cascade, Amarillo, Chinook and dry hopped for extra aroma.



#### 2. BURNING SKY BREWERY (SUSSEX) – NZPA 4.5% Pale Ale

This beer has a Maris Otter and wheat malt base and is hopped with Magnum and a slew of NZ hops. It's then dry-hopped with even more for a crisp, dry, hoppy finish.



#### 3. THE KERNEL BREWERY (LONDON) – SUMMER PALE GALAXY 4.0% Pale Ale

A Summer pale ale with powerful and fruity Galaxy hops, brewed exclusively for cask.



#### 4. ARBOR ALES (BRISTOL) – POCKET ROCKET 3.4% Pale Ale

Session pale ale, brewed with Simcoe, Citra and Mosaic hops. It has a nice balance of malt and fresh hoppy flavours and aromas.



#### 5. DEYA BREWING CO. (CHELTENHAM) – INTO THE HAZE 6.2% IPA

Soft, juicy, citrus and tropical-fruit laden IPA in the Deya Brewing house style. This beer has a clean malt structure, peachy yeast esters, and the saturated presence of Citra and Simcoe.



#### 6. TARTARUS BEERS (LEEDS) – ENFIELD 4.0% Chocolate Brownie Stout

Session stout brewed with 9 different malts and boiled for 3 hours to create a thick body and smooth mouthfeel. Coffee, chocolate and dried fruits are imparted from the malt, with the addition of chocolate and vanilla during conditioning to replicate a chocolate brownie



#### 7. SIREN CRAFT BREW (BERKSHIRE) – TEMPO 3.8% Pale Ale (Gluten Free)

Easy-drinking pale ale brewed especially for cask – a tribute to pub perfection. A clean, stripped-back malt base lets the hops shine, layered throughout for depth, structure, and mouthfeel.



#### 8. BRASS CASTLE BREWERY (MALTON) – BEST 3.9% Best Bitter

A copper-hued real Yorkshire Bitter that declares tradition and quality with every mouthful, supplying a harmonious blend of rich malt warmth, dried fruit aroma and balanced hop bitterness.



#### 9. ELUSIVE BREWING (BERKSHIRE) – REFRESH 4.2% Mango & Lime Pale Ale

This hazy and juicy Pale Ale, uses the zest and juice of over 100 limes to bring a zesty zing before adding 100 litres of pure mango puree. The mango and lime is complemented by a stone fruit hop profile.



#### 10. ATTIC BREW CO. (BIRMINGHAM) – PENNY BLACK 5.2% Porter

Rich dark malts balanced by a dry hop giving subtle spiced fruit flavours.

#### 2. BEERHOUSES BREWING – BLUESBURY ROOSTER JUICE 4.2% Pale Ale

Session Pale ale with all American hops, straw in colour with a good balance of fresh hops and smooth malt, dry hopped with loads of Citra for a juicy finish.



#### 3. SIREN CRAFT BREW (BERKSHIRE) – MEMENTO 3.8% Best Bitter

Biscuit and caramel flavours from the malts, balanced by English hops with grassy, herbal and citrus notes and refreshing bitterness. Everything is lifted by just a touch of Cascade in the dry-hop.



#### 4. TRACK BREWING CO. (MANCHESTER) – SONOMA 3.8% Pale Ale

A simple malt base & hopped generously with Mosaic, Centennial & Citra, it bursts forth with resinous notes of sticky mandarin and grapefruit. Finishing crisp & clean with a soft, pithy bitterness.



#### 5. FARM YARD BREW CO. (LANCASTER) – RAIL REPLACEMENT SERVICE 4.4% Pale Ale

This hazy hazy cask pale comes packed with mango, red berry and citrus notes from a new favourite hop – Superdelic. Soft, smooth, and full of character.

### 7. THREE ACRE BREWERY (SUSSEX) – ELDERFLOWER WHITE 4.8% Wheat Beer

A soft and refreshing white wheat beer, bursting with fresh, locally-grown elderflower from Bush Barn Farm in Robertsbridge, Sussex - complimented with Mandarin Bavaria hops.



### 9. RUNAWAY BREWERY (STOCKPORT) – RUNNING PALE 3.4% Pale Ale

Crisp, light and refreshing, but packed with flavour from citrusy US hops for a balanced, bitter finish. A modern day Mancunian classic.



### 6. OTHERWORLD BREWING (MIDLOTHIAN) – GOAT'S HEAD 4.6% PALE ALE

A hazy pale ale showcasing Krush hops for big juicy flavours of mango and peach with hints of sweet vanilla and coconut.



### 8. BLACK ISLE BREWING CO. (MUNLOCHY) – YELLOWHAMMER 4.0% Pale Ale

A golden, straw coloured bitter, brewed with Cascade hops adding a flinty, grapefruit aroma that is deliciously refreshing.



### 10. MARBLE BEERS (MANCHESTER) – LATE SUMMER PINTS 3.9% Pale Ale

Metric with a balanced measure of Lemon Drop, Citra and Simcoe in dry hop. Creating flavours of lemon, light melon, pine and citrus fruit. A perfect way to wave goodbye to those beautiful summer nights.

## MAIN BAR ROUND TWO (WHEN FIRST 10 RUN OFF)



### 1. SILENT BREW CO. (Buxton) x SURESHOT BREWING (Manchester) – Elgin's Best 5.2% Best Bitter

A modern best bitter brewed in collaboration with Sureshot, hopped with Bullion and Comet.



### 3. WYLAM BREWERY (NEWCASTLE) – REFLECTION 4.1% Pale Ale

Super bright, with light notes of tropical fruit and citrus. A harmonious blend of Strata and Superdelic hops is complemented by a well-balanced bitterness.



### 5. TWO BY TWO BREWING (NEWCASTLE) – CITRA SIMCOE EKUANOT 6.0% IPA

Big, hazy, juicy IPA brewed with Citra, Simcoe and Ekuanot hops. Tropical citrus and stone fruit aromas. Balancing bitterness with big, juicy flavours.



### 7. ABBEYDALE BREWERY (SHEFFIELD) X LOCH LOMOND BREWERY (SCOTLAND) – LIVE, LAUGH, LOCH LOMOND 4.2% Pale Ale (Gluten Free)

A light biscuity base meets uniquely flavourful Krush hops to create a fruity little number with a luscious impact.



### 9. PENTRICH BREWING CO. (DERBYSHIRE) – QUIET HEARTBEATS 4.7% Pale Ale

A naturally hazy and super hoppy pale that has juicy stone fruit & light citrus flavours dominate proceedings, complemented with some delicate floral notes. A gentle bitterness on the finish provides perfect balance to vibrantly fruity flavours.



### 2. THREE ACRE BREWERY (SUSSEX) – CASK HELLES 4.9% Helles Lager

A traditional Helles-style lager, but with a Three Acre cask spin, using German malts and hops. Classic German lager, but not as you know it.



### 4. WEEKEND PROJECT (CHESHIRE) – ROCKPORT 3.9% Pale Ale

Easy-drinking session pale ale.



### 6. COLEY'S BREWERY (MANCHESTER) – STOUT 4.5% Stout

Bringing strong flavours of extra dark chocolate, intense espresso and a slight charred smokiness, this stout is then backed up by subtle toasted nuttiness and sticky treacle.



### 8. BIG SMOKE BREW CO. (SURREY) – LEGACY 3.4% Bitter

Smooth, amber-hued ale that's fruit-forward with a lasting, balanced bitterness.



### 10. WILDE CHILD BREWING CO. (LEEDS) – BROWNIE HUNTER 4.9% Chocolate Fudge Brownie Stout

A classic low percentage stout with added lactose, cocoa powder and fudge brownie flavouring for a super smooth dessert in a glass experience.
